Memphis Jewish Home Holds Ribbon Cutting for New Rehab Facilities

Cordova, TN, December 12, 2008 - On Thursday, December 11th at 4:00pm, leaders of Memphis Jewish Home and Rehabilitation Center cut the ribbon officially opening its new rehabilitation facilities. Two separate and focused therapy gyms have been created to provide the right type and amount of space needed to provide rehabilitation services for Memphis area seniors. New equipment has also been added to each of the gyms.

The construction process was overseen by Jeff Bronze, immediate past president of the Home. "We could not have completed this process without Jeff's time, energy, and expertise," said Mary Anna Kaplan, administrator of the Home. "We appreciate all his help so much!"

Memphis Jewish Home and Rehabilitation Center converted an underutilized space in its current facility in Cordova to provide a much brighter, larger, and better configured space for rehab therapy. They still provide physical, occupational, and speech therapies. One area is where rehabilitation services will be provided on an inpatient basis. The other area is where outpatient therapy will be provided.

The outpatient therapy area has its own separate entrance on the north side of the building. Transportation can be provided for clients across the Shelby County area.
